ORDER

This matter came on for hearing before Judge Michael Silverstein on October 28, 1998 on plaintiffs' motion to enforce an order granting their motion for a preliminary injunction issued by this Court on July 8, 1998. After hearing thereon and in consideration thereof it is hereby:

Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed

- 1. The Court hereby finds that defendant has failed to comply with this Court's preliminary injunction order of July 8, 1998 (the "Order").
- 2. Accordingly, the Court now orders defendant or its agents to manipulatte, on a reasonable basis, the gates of the Pascoag Reservoir Upper Dam, Dam, Dam #16 so as to reduce the water level in the Pascoag Reservoir to achieve and maintain a water level between four feet, six inches as measured by the water marks at the gate house structure on or adjacent to the Pascaog Reservoir Upper Dam.

And, found on a seperate page the following: (note the numbers removed and hand written text added)

The Court hereby finds that defendant has failed to comply with this Court's preliminary injunction order of July 8, 1998 (the "Order").

Accordingly, the Court now orders defendant or its agents to manipulatte, on a reasonable basis,

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and hand written is the following: "The President of the Pascoag Reservoir Upper Dam Association is hereby authorized to undertake the manipulations described in this paragraph."
